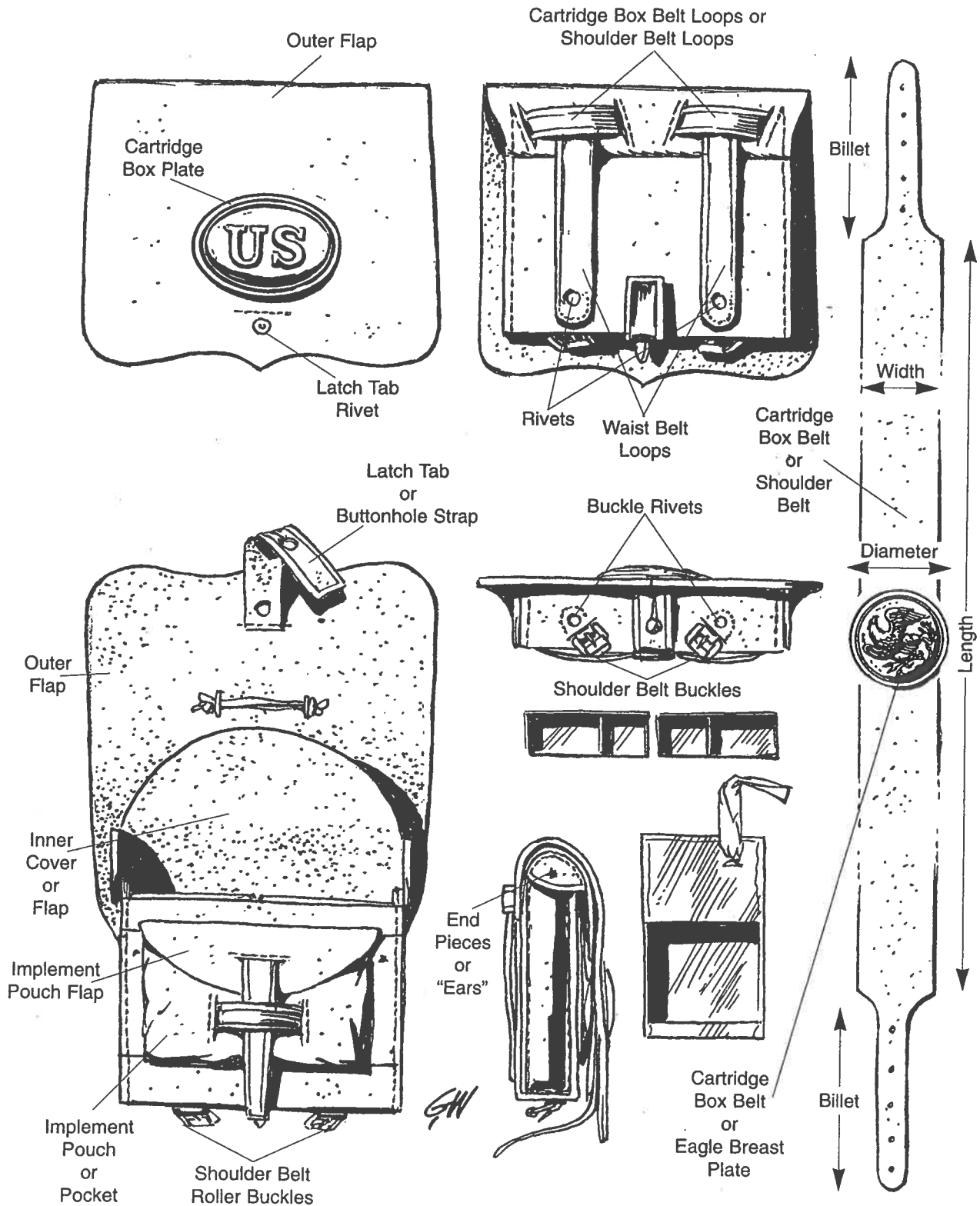
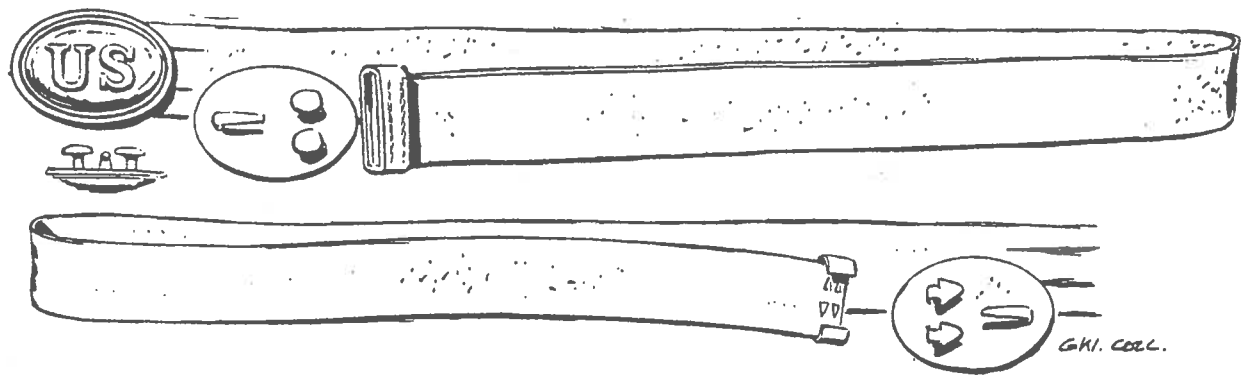

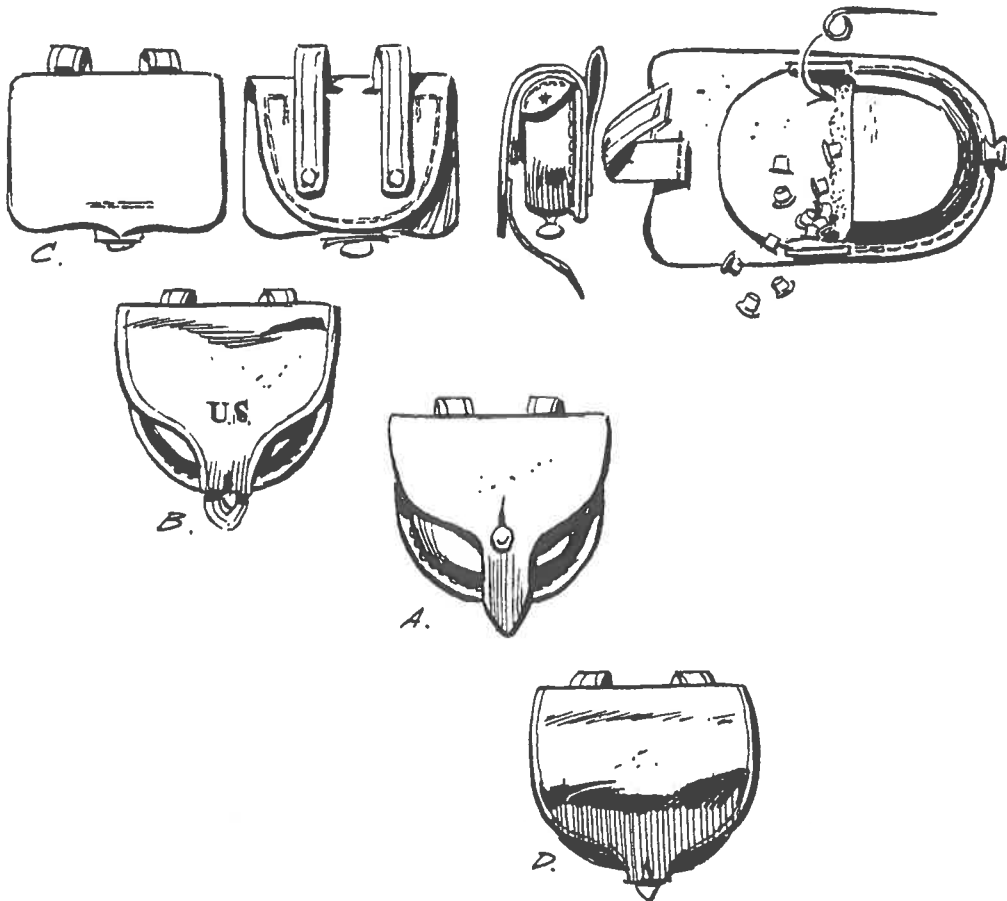


WAISTBELTS

D. 1862 through 1865



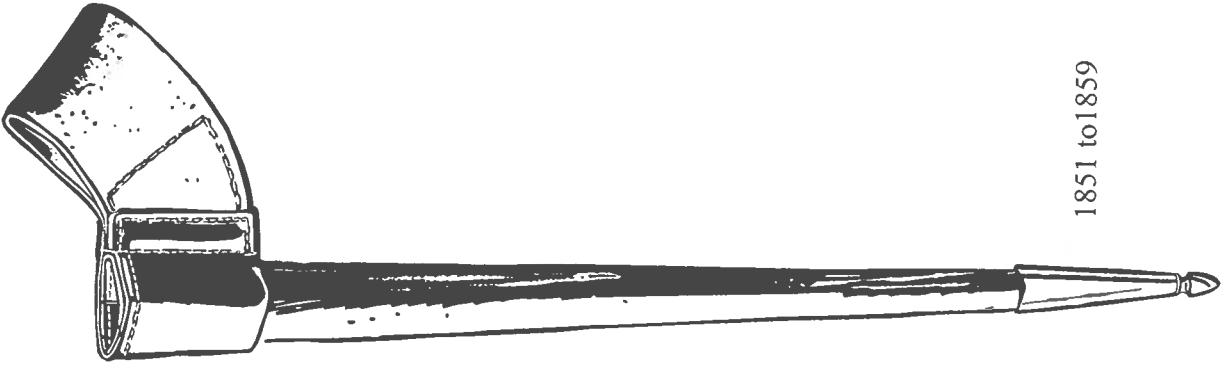
